I found in my research on Uzbekistan that this country is in great need to know about God. I also found that Seventh-day Adventist are having a part in reaching this country.

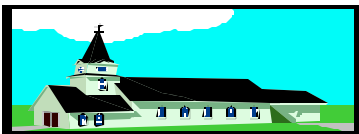

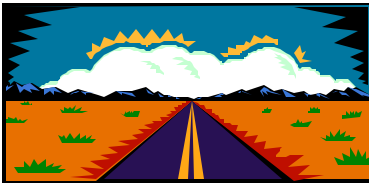
**Pray** for the Bible Studies being offered and for those participating in the studies.

**Pray** for the leaders and teachers of the Bible Studies and Health Education Classes.

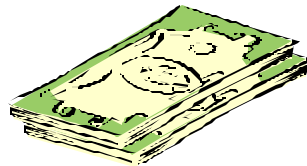
