Title: Computer Talk: The Science of Genesis Chapter 1

Subject(s): Science/Bible/Computer

Intended Grade Level(s): 1st & 2nd

Description: Using Kid Pix students will be able to:

Create pictures or hang back drops that will represent each day on creation week.

Match/Type the appropriate text to go with their picture(s).

Faith Integration: Integrating Bible and Science we will discuss the creation week and what God made on each day. The students will locate the Bible text of the day being discussed. Everyone will participate in recalling events of creation week before starting the computer portion of the assignment.

Teacher Preparation:

Teacher will teach the lesson on Creation Week.

Teacher will lead class in discussion on Creation Week.

Teacher will choose location for project (classroom/computer lab)

Teacher will first practice activity in Kid Pix Deluxe3 before introducing to students.

Teacher will introduce students to Kid Pix Deluxe3.

Teacher will demonstrate using Kid Pix Deluxe3 to students for this activity.

Teacher will lead students through a practice of using Kid Pix Deluxe3 for this activity.

Teacher will lead students through the actual lesson/activity.

Students Preparation:

Students will recall information from Genesis 1.
Students will know how to locate Bible texts from Genesis 1.
Students will be able to turn on the computer and log on.
Students will know how to use a mouse.
Students will know how to properly load software into the computer.
Students will know how to follow the teacher lead activity.

Activities/Procedures:

1. After the students have had ample enough time to learn about Creation Week, they will be introduced to the technology part of the lesson.
2. Teacher will discuss and explain the process for completing the activity.
3. Students will choose the day of Creation Week they want to work with (teacher guided so every day is covered.)
4. Students will locate the verse to go with the chosen day.
5. Students will create a picture or choose a backdrop for their verse.
6. Those students who can will type their Bible Verse across their picture. For those who can't the teacher should type for them.
7. This activity may be done as a slide show.
8. After the project is complete the students will preview their work as a whole.
9. All will properly shut down programs, remove/store software, and shut down computer.
