TEACHER'S INSERVICE WORKSHOP FOR KID PIX DELUXE 3

Description

This workshop will be for K-10 teachers. It will take place during the August teacher's inservice in Pennsylvania Conference. The workshop will introduce teachers to Kid Pix Deluxe 3 and show them how this software can be used in the classroom. The workshop will be presented using a Power Point presentation and Kid Pix Deluxe 3 software. The instructor will do demonstrations on a laptop that will be projected on a screen for the viewers. The workshop will be approximately 30 minutes in length. Resource handouts will be available for each teacher.

Objectives

1. Introduce teachers to Kid Pix Deluxe 3.
2. Illustrate why children prefer this software.
3. Demonstrate how Kid Pix can help teachers fulfill NETS (categories 1,3,&4).
4. Give examples of ways Kid Pix can be used throughout the curriculum.
5. Give teachers handouts they can take home with them to help them begin using Kid Pix Deluxe 3 in their classroom.
6. Illustrate how Kid Pix can be used for faith integration.
7. Assess effectiveness of workshop using the attached rubric as a tool.
